Sometimes when you are down, well-intentioned but ill-equipped "comforters" actually make matters worse. Such was the case with many of Israel's so-called spiritual shepherds. But after a long drought of exile, the prophet Isaiah preached the double comfort promise contained in "God's Word that stands forever" (Isa 40:8). Thus, God's preachers are called to be faithful stewards delivering this comforting Good News to Gods people (1 Cor 4:1-2).
