

# **Greetings of Christmas Morning**

- P: Behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people; for unto You is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

- C: There was no room for him in the inn.

- P: If you confess with your lips that Jesus Christ is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

- P: Say to those who are of a fearful heart, "Be strong, and do not fear. Here is your God! He will come and save you!"
- C: Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
