As We Gather

You know that line from Amazing Grace—"I once was lost, but now am found"? That's not just a lyric, it's our story. Every one of us here has wandered, gotten ourselves turned around, and ended up in places we swore we'd never go. And then—Jesus came looking. That's who He is: the Shepherd who goes after the one sheep that's gone missing. He doesn't scold, He doesn't shame—He carries. And when He brings us back, heaven throws a party. So if you came in this morning a little lost—or even a lot lost—welcome. You're in the right place. The One who knows your name has already found you, and He's glad you're here.

Luke 15:1-10

Now the tax collectors and sinners were all drawing near to hear him. ² And the Pharisees and the scribes grumbled, saying, "This man receives sinners and eats with them." 3So he told them this parable: 4 "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it? ⁵ And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. ⁶ And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost.' ⁷ Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance. ⁸"Or what woman, having ten silver coins,[a] if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp and sweep the house and seek diligently until she finds it? 9 And when she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.' ¹⁰ Just so, I tell you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents."
